Ed Wiese is going to be getting with the ROTC at Prairie High School and is looking for some help.

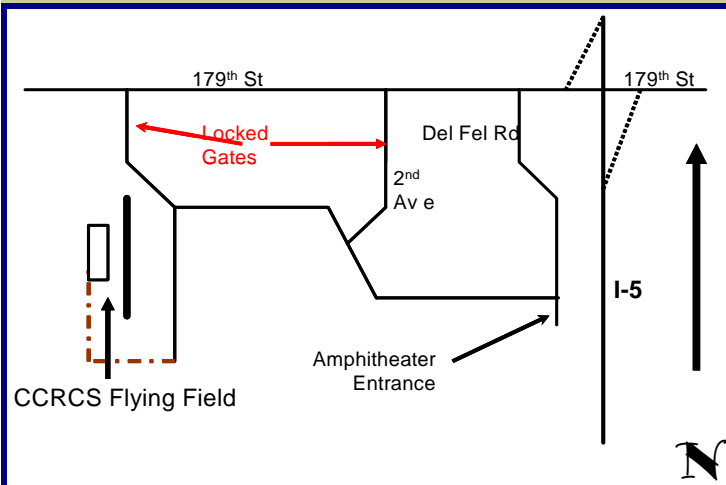
Bob McNally won the raffle prize.

Dues are \$56.00 per year, or \$4.67 per month. (If you were to join in June your dues would be \$32.69) plus \$20.00 initiation fee. Any renewal sent in before March 1<sup>st</sup> will be discounted \$5.00. (\$56.00 less \$5.00 early renewal= \$51.00)

Any member of the same household or any person holding a Junior AMA Membership receives a 50% discount on dues!

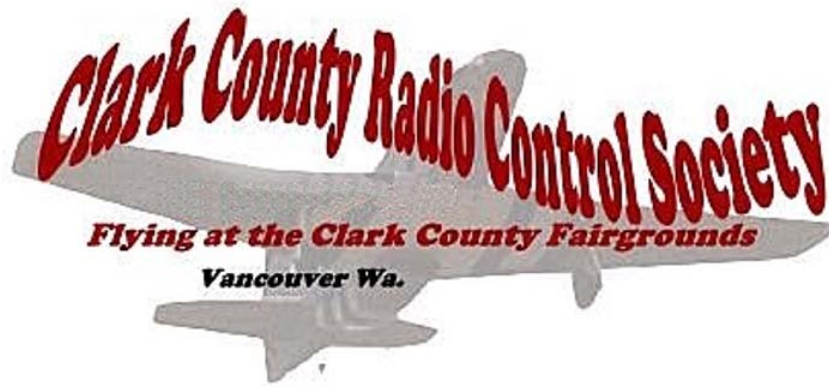

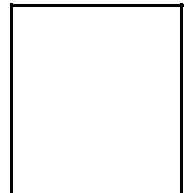

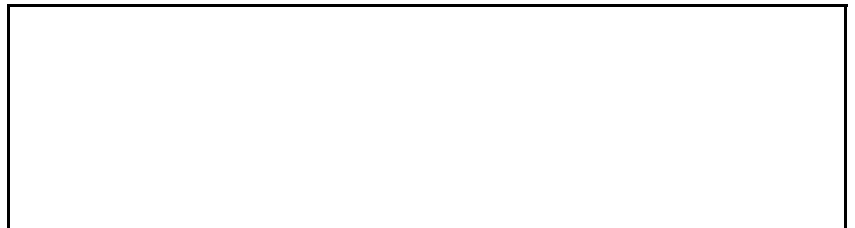
