The criers raffle was won by Bob Combs; however he was not there so the \$83.00 rolls over.

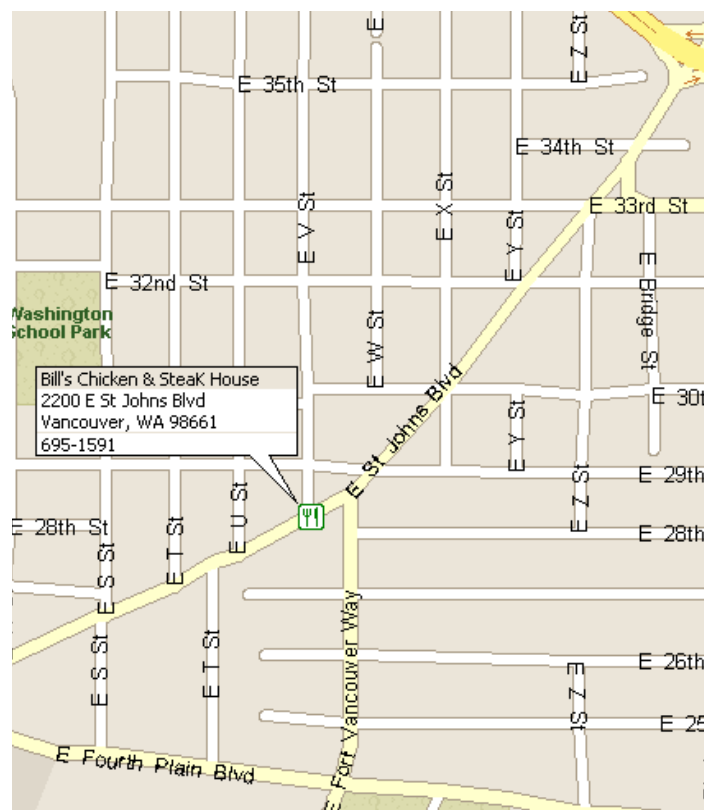

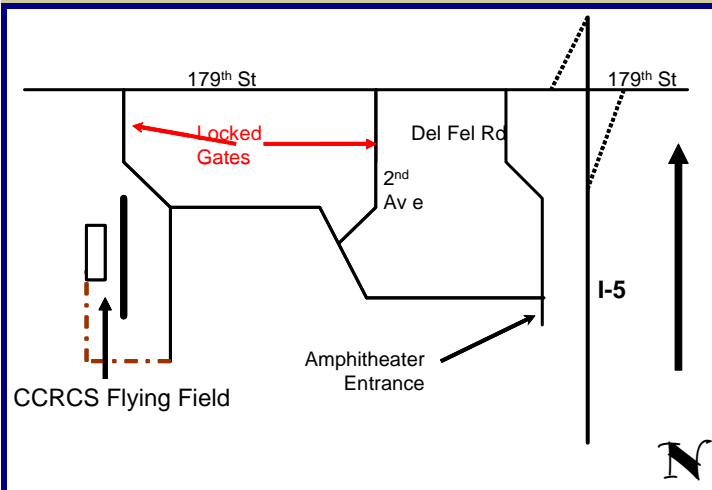
